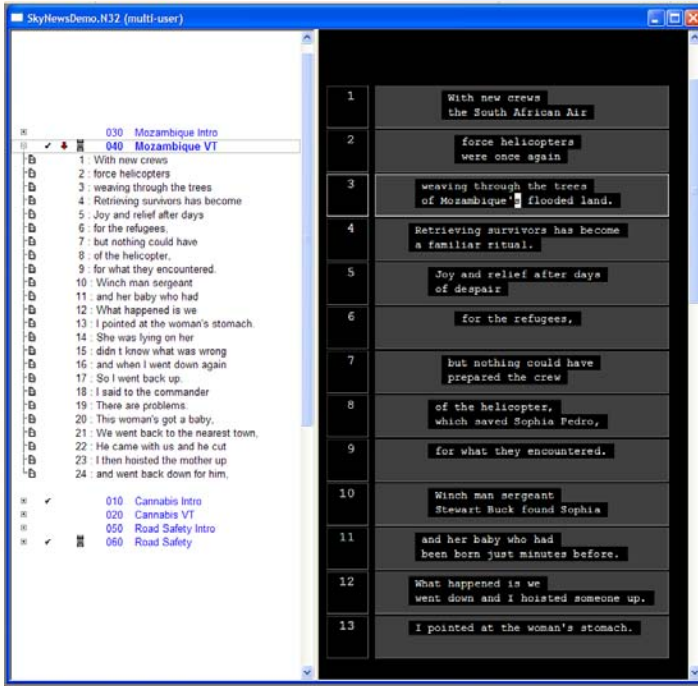


## WinCAPS News – Newsroom Interface



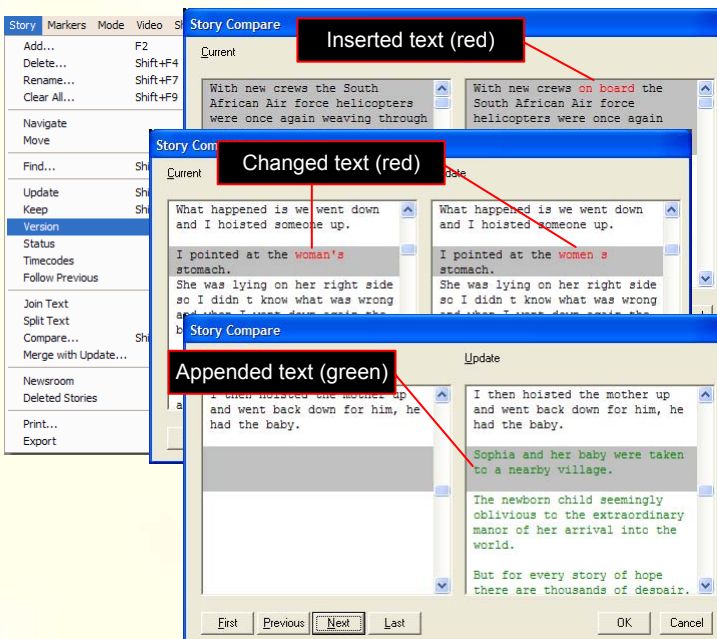
WinCAPS News is an automatic newsroom interface to increase the speed and accuracy of live subtitling.

It imports story text from the runorder in the newsroom system (filtering unwanted data such as camera cues), monitors story updates and keeps track of the position of stories in the runorder.

Each time an update occurs from the newsroom system, WinCAPS News also updates the multi-user .N32 WinCAPS subtitle file for the particular bulletin. These changes are reflected in any copy of the document open at any WinCAPS workstation.

The "split text" facility quickly breaks the story text into subtitles using the row limit and advanced linguistic and geometric text splitting rules.

Time permitting, the subtitles can be edited at any time by any user. So, even while the bulletin is on air, a user can be checking or editing a story, even the current story. For instance numbers in words can be quickly converted to digits, uppercase words (sometimes used for emphasis) converted to the correct case (Ctrl+M toggles between upper, lower and title case), journalist's phonetic spellings and typing mistakes corrected.

If the text imported from the newsroom has not yet been edited in WinCAPS then any changes in the newsroom text appear automatically in the WinCAPS equivalent. However if the user has made edits within a story, then the updates from the newsroom are stored to allow the current WinCAPS version to be compared easily with one or more newsroom versions and a quick decision made on which version to keep.
