Preview video encoding utility for subtitle approvals



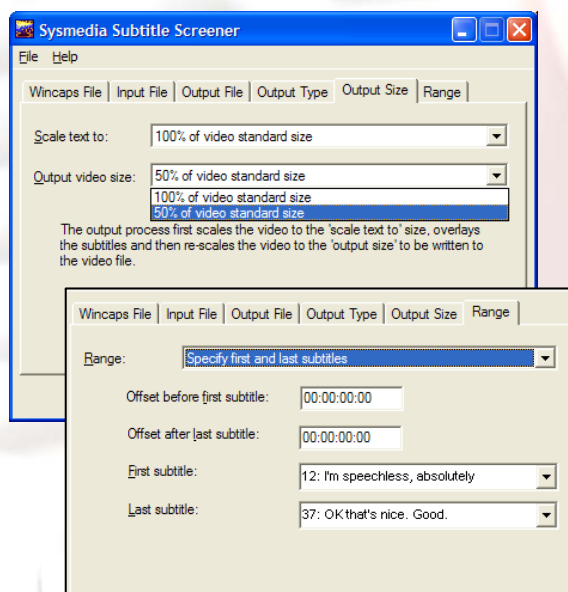
**Review real subtitled video

Programme schedulers and reviewers, lawyers or censors, external translators and end clients have traditionally been sent a VHS preview tape. Now WinCAPS makes it easy to produce a Windows Media Video file instead. This can be distributed immediately, as many times as needed, using an Internet/FTP download rather than duplicating tapes and using an expensive courier service.

WinCAPS Screener Preview is ideal for those wanting to produce subtitled video for review outside the direct subtitling team. **It's far more cost effective and convenient than using VHS tapes.**

This simple, stand-alone utility produces a WYSIWYG in-vision subtitled Windows Media video file from a standard WinCAPS subtitle file and its corresponding digital video file.



The resulting wmv video file, which can be viewed on a PC monitor using standard video player software, is a true low-resolution representation with the subtitles burnt-in to the normal picture area - as with the final DVD or broadcast version.

Text, position, colour, style and timing are all accurately represented, whether the format is open-caption, teletext or line 21 closed caption; so any subtitled video can be previewed without special hardware.

The video can be restricted to a range of subtitles, video size, text quality and bit rate are all adjustable to minimise the processing time and the size of the final video file (and therefore its associated download time).
